Work with a vision to combat corona virus spread: Monitoring officer

Dharmapuri, July 29: Dr Santhosh Babu, Principal Secretary to Tamil Nadu government besides chairman and managing director, Handicrafts Development Corporation, who is also the monitoring officer for Dharmapuri district told the department officials to work with a vision to combat COVID-19 spread by initiating preventive measures.

In his webinar session from Chennai, he asked the revenue department officials, police personnel and Intelligence Section sleuths to collect info regarding those entering Dharmapuri district from other country, other state or other district and the health department staff must monitor them by



asking them to be isolated at their dwellings without mingling with anyone. Moreover, he told the officials to ensure public wear face masks while venturing out for essential needs and they maintain social distancing at the shops. Those found without face mask must be warned and fined. All

preventive measures must be taken by the district administration to ward off coronavirus spread across the district. Regular spraying of disinfectant and sanitizing the areas should be done and to ensure hand sanitizers are used at all places. Periodical check of residential areas should

undertaken and medical check up camps is must. Details of persons above 60 must be collected and steps must be taken to ensure health department conducts check up.

All department officials must coordinate with the health department staff at the control rooms across the district, taluk and panchayat level in warding off coronavirus spread. District Collector S Malarvizhy, DRO incharge Ramamurthy, DRDA project officer Aarthy, Dharmapuri Government Medical College Hospital dean Dr Poovathy, special officer Dr Sreenivasaraj, JD health services Dr Selvi, DD health service Dr Gemini were among 75 department officials who took part at the web meet.

KMCH's timely service in COVID crisis Mobile stroke unit saves septuagenarian woman

In a first, a mobile stroke unit saved a 77 year old woman patient affected by stroke inside the van and later rushed to Kovai Medical Centre and Hospital (KMCH) where she was brought back to normal. Thanks to the timely service of the mobile unit medical staff and the driver, who reached Chinnavedampatti after receiving the call in the wee hours of yesterday.

Risking their lives during COVID-19 crisis, the medical staff and driver of KMCH mobile stroke unit braved to attend to the stroke affected patient after getting a call from the



woman's son. According to KMCH chairman Dr Nalla G Palaniswami, the advance stroke care ambulance, which is Asia's first, is always at the beck and call of the patient round-the-clock. He went on to say that it is a very hi-tech ambulance with all medical facilities launched in February 2018 is aimed at reaching the stroke

affected patient anywhere in Coimbatore quickly when the stroke hotline 95665 95665 is dialed. Notably, the mobile stroke unit is staffed with a nurse, paramedical staff, emergency personnel and CT technologist. It may be noted that the mobile stroke unit for the first time during COVID-19 crisis attended an acute stroke affected patient and

saved her from further complications. After the woman was brought to the hospital, the specialists gave some advanced treatment and she was back to normal. After she recovered fully, she was discharged. The septuagenarian thanked the medical staff for the timely gesture.

A specialist from American Stroke Association said that quick stroke treatment can save lives. Immediate treatment may minimize the long term effects of a stroke and even prevent death. Thanks to recent advances, stroke treatments and survival rates have improved considerably over the last few decade.
